# 2<sup>ND</sup> EVENT OF THE SPANISH LEAGUE EVENT OF THE ANDALUSIAN LEAGUE OF TRAIL-O

Trofeo Sierra de Huétor - 9 October 2021

### EVENT PRESENTATION

Once again, the Spanish and the Andalusian Orienteering Federations along with Club de Orientación Veleta come together to organise a brand new Trail-O event.

This time, the playing field will be the spot known as Las Mimbres, at the heart of the Sierra de Huétor Natural Park; that is why the name of this event, that will take place on 9<sup>th</sup> October 2021, is **Trofeo Sierra de Huétor Trail-O**.

This event provides points valid for the Spanish and the Andalusian Trail-O leagues, it being the 2<sup>nd</sup> event of the Spanish League of Trail-O (LETO, for its Spanish acronym) 2021 and an event of the Andalusian League of Trail-O (LATO, for its Spanish acronym).

In addition, it will be an **eligible event** to form the 2022 Spain national team that will represent our country in the different international Trail-O competitions.

A *Final Bulletin* containing the information included in this bulletin as well as possible modifications to it will be published on the Club Veleta's website. Access to the competition area is not allowed from the moment this bulletin is published until the Trail-O competition.

This event will be held the same day as the **VII Trofeo Nazaríes** *long distance race*, which will take place in Purullena (a town in the province of Granada) and that counts towards the 2021 Spanish and Andalusian Foot Orienteering Leagues. This race will be held on Saturday morning and at 30 minutes by car from the parking area of the Trail-O event, so orienteers taking part in both competitions are asked to request an **early start** for the long distance race when they fulfil their entries so that they can get in time for the Trail-O competition.



## PROGRAMME

**Saturday, 9 October 2021**

12:45: Opening of competition centre (same place as the START).

13:00: First start **Paralympic** class.

14:00: First start **Open** and **Initiation** classes.

16:30: Last start.

18:30: Finish closes.

22:00: Publication of final results on the Club Veleta's website.

## HOW TO GET THERE?

## ENTRIES

Since this event provides points for LETO (Spanish League of Trail-O) and LATO (Andalusian League of Trail-O), entries will be made via the [SICO](#) platform on the Spanish Federation's website.

## CLASSES

There will be 3 classes divided in 2 courses: an *elite course* (paralympic and open classes) and an *initiation course*. In Trail-O, classes are not divided by gender, therefore men and women compete all together.

- **PARALYMPIC:** Recommended for competitors with proven experience since this course has a very high technical difficulty. Competitors who have a permanent physical disability. A current IOF's eligibility certificate is required for competing in this class.
- **OPEN:** Recommended for competitors with proven experience since this course has a very high technical difficulty. Open to competitors of all ages.
- **INITIATION:** Recommended for competitors without much previous experience in this orienteering modality. Medium technical difficulty due to the complexity of the terrain.



- The **initiation course** presents two main differences in comparison to the elite course (paralympic and open classes):
- There is no **timed control**.
- There are no **ZERO [Z]** answers in any control.

- **Note:** At the time of publishing this bulletin, only licensed athletes can take part in official competitions due to anti-COVID regulations.

### EVENT FORMAT

**PRE-O type.** With **timed control** at first of the Pre-O course.

OPEN: +/- 26 controls, distance of 1200 metres and time limit of 115 minutes.

PARALYMPIC: +/- 26 controls, distance of 1200 metres and time limit of 130 minutes.

INITIATION: +/- 20 controls, distance of 1200 metres and time limit of 100 minutes.



## **REGULATIONS**

This event will follow the guidelines included in this and subsequent bulletins and in compliance with the regulatory frameworks of the corresponding federations and 2021 Trail-O leagues.
